## NDIS Accessing Allied Health Services

The following information will guide you through our allied health service access process as a NDIS recipient.

These are the steps you need to take to continue accessing our services under the NDIS:

- Meet with either the Local Area Coordinator (LAC) or NDIA planner to create your NDIS plan. You will receive a copy of your plan via mail or email.
- Contact our Service Access Team as soon as possible to arrange your supports and create a Service Agreement. You can email your plan to serviceaccess@glch.org.au or contact them on 5155 8367.

Please let our Service Access Team know when your next scheduled appointment is. It is important that the Service Access team have this information so they can ensure your Service Agreement is created in a timely manner that won't affect your access to our services.

3. Sign and return your Service Agreement to our Service Access Team so they can get your services in place.

Services will then commence or re-commence.
