People aged 18 and under or who hold a Commonwealth Seniors card, Pension card, DVA Gold card or Health Care Card, will generally be Bulk Billed.

Fees and Medicare rebates are current as of July 2025.

Payment is required on the day of your appointment.

Medicare claims are submitted directly to Medicare and rebates are sent by Medicare to your registered account usually within 48 hrs. Pharmacy costs may apply (payable directly to the pharmacy) if a prescription is issued as part of your care.

If you do not have a current Medicare Card

You will be charged the full fees with no rebate. Fees will also apply for pathology and radiology investigations. We do not process private health insurance claims, but we can provide a receipt to submit to your insurer.
